It's baby season! Please help us care for them.

Dear Personalized,

Baby season has officially started. The relentless storms this winter have brought us a number of unseasonably early injured and abandoned wildlife infants.

Four tiny grey squirrels, just a few days old, were found right up the street from our hospital in Barnstable. Their nest was destroyed by the wind and rain, and their mother was nowhere in sight.

They were dehydrated, lethargic, and one suffered a broken leg. Our vet team quickly provided fluid therapy and supportive care. The baby squirrel's leg fracture was immobilized in a splint and we gave him a tiny dose of pain medication.

You can imagine the intensive care these early babies require. Our vet techs now feed them special formula from a syringe four to six times a day. We keep them in incubators until they are healthy enough to move to indoor cages, and finally to larger outdoor cages when the weather is milder.

If the babies are sick or injured, like our little squirrel, they are monitored closely and provided with additional treatment and tests. Some require x-rays, blood testing, or even surgery.
